



The Knowsys PSAT-SAT National Merit Potentials Course is specifically designed for students with a high 10th grade PSAT score. The goal is to help those top-level students achieve National Merit Commended and higher levels of recognition on the PSAT and maximize their SAT score.

PSAT National Merit Potentials Course Pedagogy, Strategies, and Methods:

The Knowsys National Merit Potentials Course is designed to enable high-scoring students to maximize their scores. The course focuses on the concepts frequently missed by high-scoring students and the questions that the College Board designates as Medium and Hard (on an Easy-Medium-Hard scale). The Knowsys course is efficient because we design the course based on our 22 years of experience working with top-scoring students. Students find themselves challenged and propelled to the next level in Math, Critical Reading, Grammar, and SAT vocabulary. Following the PSAT in October of the students' Junior year, the course switches gears to focus on the SAT: scoring, timing, and the essay. The goal is to keep the momentum rolling and enable students to maximize their SAT scores as well. An ACT component can be added at the end for districts that emphasize the ACT exam.
